Alexander Rieck

Dipl.-Ing. Alexander Rieck is a researcher at the Fraunhofer Institute for Industrial Engineering (IAO) in Stuttgart.

Rieck studied architecture in Stuttgart and in Arizona. He took his diploma in 1997 as one of the first in virtual reality (CAVE). He subsequently worked at the Virtual Reality Lab of the IAO in Stuttgart, where he focussed on the optimization of planning methods in virtual space.

Since 1998, Rieck is employed at the Competence Centre New Work, where he concentrates on the development of future scenarios for human working behavior and the cities these humans inhabit.

As a senior scientist, he played a major role in the success of the collaborative research project OFFICE 21. He also directs the joint project FutureHotel FUCON. Recently, Rieck has been responsible for the bundling of innovative developments of the ILO in the construction sector.

Parallel to his academic career, he founded LAVA Architects together with his partners Chris Bosse and Tobias Walliser in 2007. LAVA has offices in Stuttgart, Sydney and Abu Dhabi.
